Red Think Rising

On September 21, a protest was held in Aurora, Colorado demanding abolishment of US borders and the Immigration & Customs Enforcement agency. Over the last three years, a myriad of similar anti-ICE, open-border demonstrations have been held in cities across America, all of which have been encouraged and supported, tacitly or otherwise, by the Democratic Party.

One of several Democratic front groups that participated in the protest calls itself the Party for Socialism and Liberation/Denver. To make sure its Marxist ideology doesn't go unnoticed, the group's Facebook page reads "Building a Worker's Paradise in the Heartland of World Imperialism." PSL/Denver's name includes the word socialism, but the communist flag flown at its Aurora protest shows that to this profoundly anti-American group, socialism and communism are heads of the same snake.

The open borders demonstration was also attended by members of Rocky Mountain Antifa and Denver Communists, two other openly Marxist Democrat front groups. In [a video at *AmericanThinker.com*], a member of Denver Communists confirms that the protestors are demanding elimination of US borders and an end to enforcement of US immigration law. An image on the group's Facebook page shows members carrying a banner demanding no borders and no nations.

A borderless world without nations represents the culmination of the communist dream of a world united under the banner of the hammer and sickle. For that dream to be realized, America's sovereignty must be yielded to an international governing body run by the UN, a one-world globalist organization run by an international assortment of socialists-cumcommunists. Those who call for a borderless world with no nations are effectively calling for a permanent end to the United States in favor of a "new world order," a world where Americans would be indoctrinated to no longer see themselves as citizens of their country, but as Citizens of the World.

Occupy Denver is another anti-capitalist group that showed up for the demonstration in Aurora. Hundreds of Occupy affiliates are active in cities, towns, and campuses across America. Like other Democrat identity politics groups, Occupy affiliates are openly pro-communist—Occupy Denver's Facebook profile picture contains an image of "the Raised Fist," one of communism's most recognizable call to arms. Like other Democrat front groups, Occupy Denver helps the Democratic Party advance its hostility toward the police by mocking and ridiculing law enforcement officers, as shown in this photo on the group's Facebook. Another photo on the group's Facebook supports the Democrats' class warfare election strategy with an "us vs. them" propaganda graphic declaring that the poor in America are exploited victims of oppression, who therefore have a right to "destroy the system," by violence if necessary. Victim vs. oppressor ideology is the means of achieving political power outlined in *The Communist Manifesto*.

The ties that bind the modern Democratic Party to pro-communist groups and organizations are unmistakable. Nowhere is that more evident than its ties to the Occupy movement. At an Aug. 19, 2012 pre-rally "People's Assembly" meeting in the nation's capitol, former labor boss/lifelong Democrat Mike Golash, leader of Occupy DC and a member of the openly-communist Progressive Labor Party, left no doubt about the intent of the Occupy movement when he was caught on video telling student occupiers "Our goal is to make revolution in the United States, overthrow the capitalist system and build communism in America." Another prominent Democrat who supports the anti-capitalist Occupy movement is a self-declared communist named Bill Ayers, in whose living room Barack Obama launched his political career. And, when Occupy Wall Street protests burst on the scene in 2011, the two most high profile Democrats in America—President Obama ("We are on their side") and Speaker Nancy Pelosi ("God bless them")—enthusiastically supported

the 99% vs. the 1%, victim vs. oppressor protests, as did virtually every other high level official in the Democratic Party.

The Aurora protestors who demanded no borders and no nations—and millions more like them who share their borderless world ideology—have three things in common.

- They all are Americans who harbor deep contempt for their country.
- They all are communist revolutionaries committed to overthrowing America's two-party capitalist system by any means necessary.
- They all support and are supported by the modern Democratic Party, a once-patriotic party that has quietly defected to the side of the hammer and sickle.

Overwhelming evidence shows that the red tide of communism is rising in America, and rapidly so. Whether it succeeds in upending our constitutional republic will be determined by the next national elections.

Socialism's Unbroken Trail of Failure

Evidence that socialism is doomed to fail wherever it is tried occurred long before America became a nation. In 1607, inhabitants of Jamestown, Virginia were on the verge of starvation, largely because the settlement's communal living arrangement failed to produce enough food. Among the steps that saved Jamestown from oblivion was doing away with communal sharing in favor of incentive-based farming that rewarded personal initiative.

Three and a half centuries later, the same lesson repeated itself in San Francisco and elsewhere, when the utopian "free food" communes of the hip generation went the way of the dinosaurs. The hippies who provided the food got tired of feeding those whose only contribution was a hearty appetite. Earlier this year, socialism's empty promise of a honeyed existence for all struck again, this time in Scandinavia, where Finland's socialist government collapsed over the unsustainable cost of passing out free stuff as if it grew on trees.

Having left an unbroken trail of failure in its wake, socialism is doomed to fail wherever it's tried, because it

is in eternal mortal conflict with the basic human instinct that those who work hard, pursue advanced education, employ their ingenuity, or risk their capital have an inborn expectation to do significantly better than those who don't. As 18th century Scottish economist Adam Smith put it, "it is not from the benevolence of the butcher, the brewer, or the baker that we expect our dinner, but from their regard to their own self-interest." Stated differently, every socialist who works for a living does so not out of altruistic instincts, but to feather his own financial nest. That, too, will never change.

Socialists attempt to subvert free societies via stealth and deceit. Here are four of the most outlandish lies they tell:

- "We're not socialists. We're democratic socialists." There is no difference in the two. The word "democratic" is inserted as a Trojan horse to cloak the socialist soldier.
 - "Socialism is about sharing."

This lie projects the absurd notion that socialists are morally superior people worthy of being emulated. Nothing could be farther from the truth. Sharing is a voluntary act based on love; socialism is forced sharing.

• "Socialism creates fairness and equality for all."

One of the most chilling commands in *The Communist Manifesto* is this: "The theory of communism can be summed up in one sentence: Abolish all private property." In socialist countries, the only people who own high-value assets are the socialist rulers and their loyal cronies. Because there is little upward mobility under socialism, socialist societies are characterized by two economic levels: a small, immensely wealthy ruling elite at the top, and at the bottom, the low-income masses forced to obey the dictates of their socialist masters. A large and prosperous middle class like what we have in America does not exist in countries with single-party socialist rule. Those who doubt that need only ask people who have lived in such places.

• "Socialism will work if the right people are in charge."

This fallacious assertion is an attempt to explain away socialism's unbroken trail of failure. The scourge of socialism has never created a single free and prosperous society, but has destroyed every functioning society where it was allowed to metastasize. One hundred percent of those who think socialism will work if the "right people" are in charge are referred to as useful idiots, a class of gullible citizens duped to believe that the universally failed theories of Marx and Lenin are the answer to

wealth and income disparity.

In one of his most revealing quotes, Lenin said, "The goal of socialism is communism." The idea that creeping socialism should precede communism is an acknowledgment that totalitarian rule is so frightening to people in free nations that it must be quietly slipped into those societies in bits and pieces. It is through that incremental process that socialism serves as an under-the-radar, transitional gateway to the unrelenting oppression of full-blown communism.

The EAT THE RICH class warfare image above illustrates that gradual subversion—from capitalism (knife and fork) to creeping socialism (fork and sickle) to outright communism (hammer and sickle). If done via stealth and deception, free societies can be overthrown from within in a way that goes virtually unnoticed until it's too late. The means through which that sub rosa conversion is accomplished is called Cultural Marxism.

One of the leading Marxist thinkers of the 20th century, the late Italian communist Antonio Gramsci, is known as the Father of Cultural Marxism. Disillusioned that he and his communist fellow travelers failed to incite a Bolshevik-style revolution in their capitalist country, Gramsci developed a stratagem to peacefully overturn capitalism in Western societies from within. That stratagem is known as Cultural Marxism, the process of gradually infusing communist doctrine into a society via its culture.

Gramsci theorized that what holds a capitalist society together are the pillars of its culture, the structures and institutions of family, religion, education, politics, law, the arts, and the media, as they provide the social cohesion necessary to a functioning society. Undermine the principles that these structural institutions embody, and a capitalist society can be subverted from within without firing a shot.

A prime example of an undermined structural institution in this country is its public education system, which has been heavily infiltrated by progressive teachers and administrators who have, over the last half-century, methodically indoctrinated generations of impressionable young minds with the alleged virtues of socialism. The ultimate goal of that subversive indoctrination is to supplant the values of the Founders with those of Marx and Lenin. In many of our public schools, teachers, who traditionally embody socially approved values, are no longer teaching their students to be proud of their country; they're teaching them to be ashamed of their country and its two-party capitalist system.

In 16th-century Spain, Catholic missionary Saint Francis Xavier is quoted as saying, "Give me the child until he is seven and I will show you the man." What children are taught in school today will determine what kind of country we have in the future. The relentless socialist brainwashing of America's schoolchildren has yielded troubling results. A recent poll by the Victims of Communism Memorial Foundation found that 7 in 10 Millennials surveyed said they would vote for a socialist in the next election.

With Cultural Marxism having penetrated every facet of our society, the tentacles of socialism-cum-communism have quietly seized control of virtually every structural institution in our country, including, most ominously, one of America's major political parties and what has become that party's willing propaganda arm, the journalistically corrupt mainstream media. A free nation cannot long survive if its press takes sides, so it's not hyperbole to say the great American experiment in representative democracy is staring squarely into the abyss of tyranny. We the People—our votes, our time, our money—are the only thing standing in the way. The next election will determine whether our constitutional republic survives or falls from within to the iron hand of single-party socialist rule.

Eternal Impeachment

What is the level of happiness among modern American leftists about the impeachment of President Trump? Do they celebrate this Christmas gift on the streets? (Sorry, my fellow collectivists, there is no attempt here to offend you with the word "Christmas"). One would assume that leftists do celebrate the event, but the reality is quite different and more complex.

The Communist Party USA (official ideology—Communism and Marxism-Leninism), on the surface, congratulates its ideological comrades, Democrats (also known as Demsheviks) but, at the same time, offers some reservations and demands staying focused on the ultimate goal:

Come what may from the impeachment process Trump should be voted out in November for putting asylees in concentration camps; encouraging extreme-right, nationalist, racist hatred and violence; giving tax breaks to the rich; defanging regulatory agencies, hanging out with neo-Nazis, and reducing aid to the poor. He should be voted for trying to break the back of labor, attacking women, and suppressing the black, Latino and youth vote.

The Revolutionary Communists Party USA (official ideology—Communism and Maoism) is more sincere in congratulatory condemnation of Democrats and proclaims, "Can anyone dispute that the Trump/Pence regime poses a catastrophic danger to humanity? Concentration camps on the border . . . environmental devastation accelerated . . . war, even nuclear war, casually threatened . . . white supremacist rule . . . fascist mobs and racist mass murderers . . . truth and science erased . . . the right to abortion near gone . . . the rule of law and democratic and civil rights stripped away . . ."

The Fourth (Socialist) International (official ideology: Trotskyism), while jubilant about impeachment, unloads on Democrats who agreed with Trump on USMCA and approved the National Defense Authorization Act, calling it "extraordinary juxtaposition of impeachment and political collaboration to its climax." However, the international socialists make an astonishing conclusion that Democrats' "emphasis on the politics of racial and gender identity alienates rather that attracts the support of the working class."

Workers World Party (official ideology: Communism, Marxism-Leninism, and Proletarian International-

ism), commenting on the impeachment, highlights that "the current impeachment by the House does not indict the president for crimes against humanity. Instead, the House impeached him for failing to support US imperialism." Talking about Ukrainegate, they emphasize that "there is nothing this president or the Republican Party has done that has helped any section of the working class in the US and nearly everything he has done has hurt oppressed workers, the poor, women, LGBTQ2S+ people. Compared to these harmful acts, withholding military aid from Ukraine is hardly a crime—although the president did it for dishonest reasons."

"Hardly a crime"? Who would suspect such a level of critical thinking from the party of "oppressed workers"?

The Socialist Workers' Party (official ideology: Communism, Marxism-Leninism, and Castroism) openly utilizes right-wing arguments to attack its left-wing comrades: "As Democrats advanced their witch hunt against President Donald Trump aimed at overturning the 2016 election, State Department Inspector General Michael Horowitz released his report on FBI spy operations targeting Trump's election campaign then. Horowitz's account exposes how Washington's political police lied and maneuvered to attack the Trump campaign. What he fails to mention is that spying and disruption is what they have repeatedly done and will do again against fighting workers and working-class organizations. . . . The liberals have spent the three years since the president was elected in a campaign to criminalize his political differences and, above all, to attack the workers they blame for his victory."

Amazing, isn't it?

The Party Socialist Alternative (official ideology: Democratic Socialism, Marxism, and Trotskyism), like many other leftist organizations, concludes that "we must warn that the strategy of the Democratic Party could seriously backfire. Their uninspiring approach to impeachment, combined with their lackluster establishment candidates in the 2020 race, are not providing any real vision of an alternative to Trump."

In other words, the consensus among fellow leftists is that "Democrats let Trump off the hook."

The Party of Socialism and Liberation (official ideology—Communism, Marxism-Leninism, and Revolutionary Socialism) does not hide its dissatisfaction with Democrats: "The Democrats' impeachment case against the despicable Trump regime had nothing to do with what actually makes it despicable. Trump is openly racist, sexist, anti-environment, anti-labor, homophobic, anti-poor, anti-homeless, anti-Palestinian, and more. But the Democratic party leaders' impeachment strategy deliberately ignored all of that and instead revolved around the ludicrous charge that Trump weakened 'our national security' by delaying a shipment of anti-tank missiles, sniper rifles, and other military equipment to Ukraine for war against Russia."

That is too much, folks. Who would predict that leftists would dare to call Trump's Articles of Impeachment a "ludicrous charge"?

What is going on? One could understand that intraspecific competition among leftists is fierce, but who would predict most of American leftists unite against not only Trump, but their fellow comrades-in-ideological-arms—Democrats? Leftists still are not able to decide if they have impeached Trump or not and appear confused about what the next steps should be. Across the full spectrum of Leftism—from Marxism, Stalinism, and Trotsky-ism to Democratic Socialism—many are calling Pelosi's impeachment a "fiasco" and a "road to nowhere."

It would be improper to attribute the brutal post-impeachment infighting among the leftists solely to some concrete actions of Trump. To be precise, the post-impeachment ripping at each other's throats and the overall crisis among leftists is one of these pleasant but unpredictable side-effects of Trump's remedy for America.

Bill Clinton's infamous answer to the question about cheating with Monica Lewinsky was, "I think I did something for the worst possible reason: just because I could." Demsheviks impeached President Trump for exactly the same worst possible reason: just because they could.

In addition, Demsheviks came up with a new, previously unheard of method of political blackmail—permanent impeachment.

Under the leadership of Pelosi, the House of Representatives is about to turn into a Perpetuum Mobile for the production of numerous impeachments of Trump. Most likely, the majority, if not all, of these future impeachments will never reach the Senate. In other words, the Democrats' strategy, which is contrary to the Constitution, is to ensure that the trial of Trump in the Senate does not take place, and thus Trump does not get what he counts on: an acquittal. As conceived by the Demsheviks, these numerous impeachments will hang over Trump.

Contrary to Demsheviks, there is no discussion and no doubt among conservatives that President Trump was, in fact, impeached. However, if the previous actions of President Trump are teaching us something, we are pretty much sure that the political payback is coming, and the unexpected leftists' infighting is precisely the stage Trump needs.

Prager vs. Christianity Today by Dennis Prager

The editor-in-chief of *Christianity Today*, Mark Galli, wrote an editorial calling for the impeachment of President Donald Trump.

In my view, this editorial only serves to confirm one of the sadder realizations of my life: that religious conviction guarantees neither moral clarity nor common sense.

The gist of the editorial—and of most religious and conservative opposition to Mr. Trump—is that any good the president has done is dwarfed by his character defects.

This is an amoral view that says more about Mr. Galli than it does about the president. He and the people who share his opinion are making the following statement: No matter how much good this president does, it is less important than his character flaws.

Why is this wrong?

First, because it devalues policies that benefit millions of people.

And second, because it is a simplistic view of character.

I do not know how to assess a person's character—including my own—outside of how one's actions affect others. Because I agree with almost all of Mr. Trump's actions as president and believe they have positively affected millions of people, I have to conclude that as president, Mr. Trump thus far has been a man of particularly good character.

Of course, if you think his policies have harmed millions of people, you will assess his character negatively. But that is not what never-Trump conservatives or Christians such as the *Christianity Today* editor-in-chief argue. They argue that his policies have indeed helped America (and even the world), but this fact is far less significant than his character.

In the words of Mr. Galli: "(I)t's time to call a spade a spade, to say that no matter how many hands we win in this political poker game, we are playing with a stacked deck of gross immorality and ethical incompetence." This rhetorical sleight of hand reflects poorly on Mr. Galli's intellectual and moral honesty.

Mr. Galli and every other Christian and conservative opponent of the president believe their concerns are moral, and that the president's Christian and other conservative supporters are political.

This is simply wrong.

I and every other supporter of the president I know support him for moral reasons, not to win a "political poker game." Mr. Galli's view is purely self-serving; he's saying, "We Christian and other conservative opponents of the president think in moral terms, while Christian and other conservative supporters of the president think in political terms."

So, permit me to inform Mr. Galli and all the other people who consider themselves conservative and/or Christian that our support for the president is entirely moral.

- To us, putting pressure on the Iranian regime—one of the most evil and dangerous regimes on Earth—by getting out of the Iran nuclear deal made by former President Barack Obama is a moral issue. Even *New York Times* columnist Bret Stephens, who loathes Mr. Trump, has written how important the president's rejection of the Obama-Iran agreement has been.
- To us, enabling millions of black Americans to find work—resulting in the lowest black unemployment rate ever recorded—is a moral issue.
- To us, more Americans than ever being employed and almost 4 million Americans freed from reliance on food stamps is a moral issue.
- To us, appointing more conservative judges than any president in history—over the same period of time—is a moral issue. That whether the courts, including the Supreme Court, are dominated by the left or by conservatives is dismissed by Mr. Galli as "political poker" makes one question not only Galli's moral thinking but also his moral theology.
- To us, moving the American embassy to Israel's capital city, Jerusalem—something promised by almost every presidential candidate—is a moral issue, not to mention profoundly courageous. And courage is a moral virtue.
- To us, increasing the US military budget—after the severe cuts of the previous eight years—is a moral issue. As conservatives see it, the American military is the world's greatest guarantor of world peace.

Yet, none of these things matter to Mr. Galli and other misguided Christians and conservatives. What matters

more to them is Mr. Trump's occasional crude language and intemperate tweets, what he said about women in a private conversation and his having committed adultery.

Regarding adultery, that sin is for spouses and God to judge. There is no connection between marital sexual fidelity and moral leadership. I wish there were. And as regards the "Access Hollywood" tape, every religious person, indeed every thinking person, should understand that there is no connection between what people say privately and their ability to be a moral leader. That's why I wrote a column for the *Wall Street Journal* 20 years ago defending Hillary Clinton when she was charged with having privately expressed anti-Semitic sentiments.

That the editor of *Christianity Today* thinks the president's personal flaws, whatever they might be, are more important than all the good he has done for conservatives, for Christians, for Jews, for blacks, and for America tells us a lot . . . about Mr. Galli and the decline of Christian moral thought.

The Frankfurt School

The partisan impeachment of President Donald Trump, its shredding of the Constitution and disregard for due process, are just symptoms of the Democrat party's abandonment of both democracy and sanity in its ruthless pursuit of permanent political power at any cost.

Although it may appear inexplicable, the behavior of the modern Democrat party is not without historical precedent. As Democrats continue their political march leftward, they have begun to adopt the non-democratic tactics of the extreme left.

After the successful 1917 communist revolution in Russia, the political left widely believed that a violent proletarian revolt would sweep across Europe and, ultimately, North America. It did not.

As a result, the Communist International began to investigate other ways to create the state of societal hopelessness and alienation necessary as a prerequisite for socialist revolution—in essence, to erode western democracy from within.

The single, most important organizational component of that effort was a Communist think tank called the Institute for Social Research, popularly known as the

Frankfurt School.

The task of the Frankfurt School was first, to undermine the foundation of Western civilization that emphasized the uniqueness of the individual and, second, to determine new cultural forms that would increase the disaffection of and division among the population.

Just as in classical economic Marxism, certain groups like workers and peasants are *a priori* good, and other groups like the bourgeoisie and capital owners are evil, in Cultural Marxism, feminists, racial and ethnic minorities, and those who define themselves according to sexual orientation are deemed good and "victims" of societal injustice. It logically follows, then, that white males and "privilege" and, by extension, Western civilization, are automatically and irredeemably malevolent.

To many Americans, the Democrat party promotes policies that undermine the United States as a sovereign nation, our Constitution, our culture, our traditions, all of what "America" has come to mean. Part of that effort is to weaken our ability to transmit to the next generation the values and traditions upon which the United States was built.

The Democrat party's assault on the First Amendment is meant to narrow the range of thought in order to make independent thinking literally impossible, because there will be no words in which to express those thoughts. It is accomplished through the systematic destruction of language as "microaggressions" or endlessly repeating statements that are patently untrue, like the existence of more than two biological genders.

The widespread political intolerance promoted by the Democrats and their media allies is largely based on the essay "Repressive Tolerance" written in 1965 by Herbert Marcuse, an adherent of the Frankfurt School.

Fred Bauer, in his article "The Left and 'Discriminating Tolerance," captures Marcuse's inverted logic and identifies the origin of the political intolerance presently practiced at US academic institutions:

Marcuse argued that, because of the radical repressiveness of Western society, a tolerance for all viewpoints actually contributed to social oppression. A pervasive network of assumptions and biases implicitly privileges the viewpoint of the powerful, so that seemingly 'equal' presentations of opposite opinions actually end up benefiting the viewpoint of the powerful. In the light of this situation, Marcuse made a rather cunning inversion (one that has been aped countless times since by cultural organs across the United States): The fact that society is so radically unequal means that we should be intolerant and repressive in the name of tolerance and liberty.

The inevitable outcome of Democrat policies is a dystopia, characterized by a cataclysmic decline of a society, in which a totalitarian government enforces ruthless egalitarianism by suppressing or denouncing ability and accomplishment, or even competence, as forms of inequality. It creates complete dependency on the state and attempts to eradicate the family as a social institution.

In his article, "Why Americans Are Not Taught History," Christopher Hitchens, identified the vulnerability of America's present-tense culture to the Democrat party's leftist utopian myth.

For the true blissed-out and vacant servitude required by the Democrats' strategy, you need a society that lacks any sense of itself through an understanding of its own history and traditions. The low-information voter will submit to a combination of governmental coercion as in George Orwell's *Nineteen Eighty-Four* and the hedonist nihilism of a painless, amusement-sodden, and stress-free consensus managed by the nanny-state found in Aldous Huxley's *Brave New World*.

No matter how idealistic are the foundations of the United States or how honorable its previous history, the accumulation of excessive power in the federal government transforms it into a dysfunctional super-state dedicated to maintaining its own power irrespective of the well-being of its citizens.

In a dystopia, history, truth and the law are just chalkwriting on a blackboard, which can be erased and rewritten whenever it suits the convenience and desires of a government of perfidious politicians.

We just witnessed an example of that behavior in the impeachment of President Trump.
